
The EAP office, on UNL's City Campus is located south of Memorial Stadium on Stadium Drive and affords convenient parking for visitors.

## **WORKPLACE SERVICES**

- Management Consultation
- EAP professionals are available to supervisors for confidential consultations regarding an employee's work performance problems.
- Supervisor Consultation
- A supervisor or department chair might have noticed that an employee's job performance has declined from what may be personal problems. They can contact EAP and strategize how they might encourage the employee to seek assistance.
- Conflict Resolution
- EAP provides an objective third party to help resolve interpersonal conflicts within the workplace between employees of approximately equal positions.

## **LEAVE PROVISIONS**

If you are referred by your supervisor and/or choose to inform your supervisor of your EAP appointment, you are eligible to use administrative leave up to a maximum of five hours per calendar year or you may arrange to use vacation or sick leave. The EAP has appointments available during lunch hours and limited evening appointments.

## CONFIDENTIALITY

Confidentiality of EAP clients is guaranteed except in certain imminent life-threatening circumstances, such as a threat of suicide or homicide, as well as child or elder abuse.

The staff at UNL's EAP are experienced workplace consultants and clinicians who hold advanced degrees and are fully licensed by the State of Nebraska.
