



Certificate of Drug and Alcohol Training for Supervisors

INSTRUCTIONS:

[§49 CFR 382.603] The United States Department of Transportation (DOT) require the University of Nebraska to provide training to University supervisors who are designated to determine when there is a reasonable suspicion to test a CDL driver for drugs and/or alcohol misuse, and at least an additional sixty (60) minutes of training on alcohol misuse, and at least an additional sixty (60) minutes of training on controlled substance use and abuse. At the University of Nebraska, this training is accomplished through the use of training videos and written materials. After viewing the video and reading the written materials, this form must be completed to document the receipt of such training.

This form will be retained with other records maintained by the Department of Human Resources along with other CDL Drug and Alcohol testing program records. You may request a copy of this certification.
